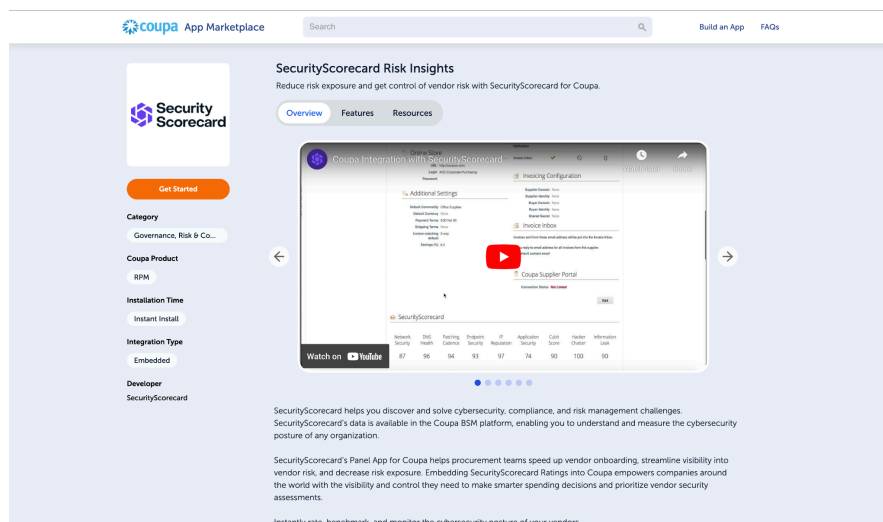
# SecurityScorecard Cybersecurity Risk Insights App for Coupa

Getting started with SecurityScorecard Cybersecurity Risk Insights is an easy process. The setup outline in this guide should be completed by your Company's Coupa and SecurityScorecard admin.


**Important Note:** Users installing only the panel app for the Coupa Core platform, will need to complete Steps 1-4. To add SecurityScorecard Cybersecurity Risk Insights to the Coupa Risk Aware module, complete Steps 1-4, then continue to complete Steps 5-7.

### Step 1 - Install Panel App

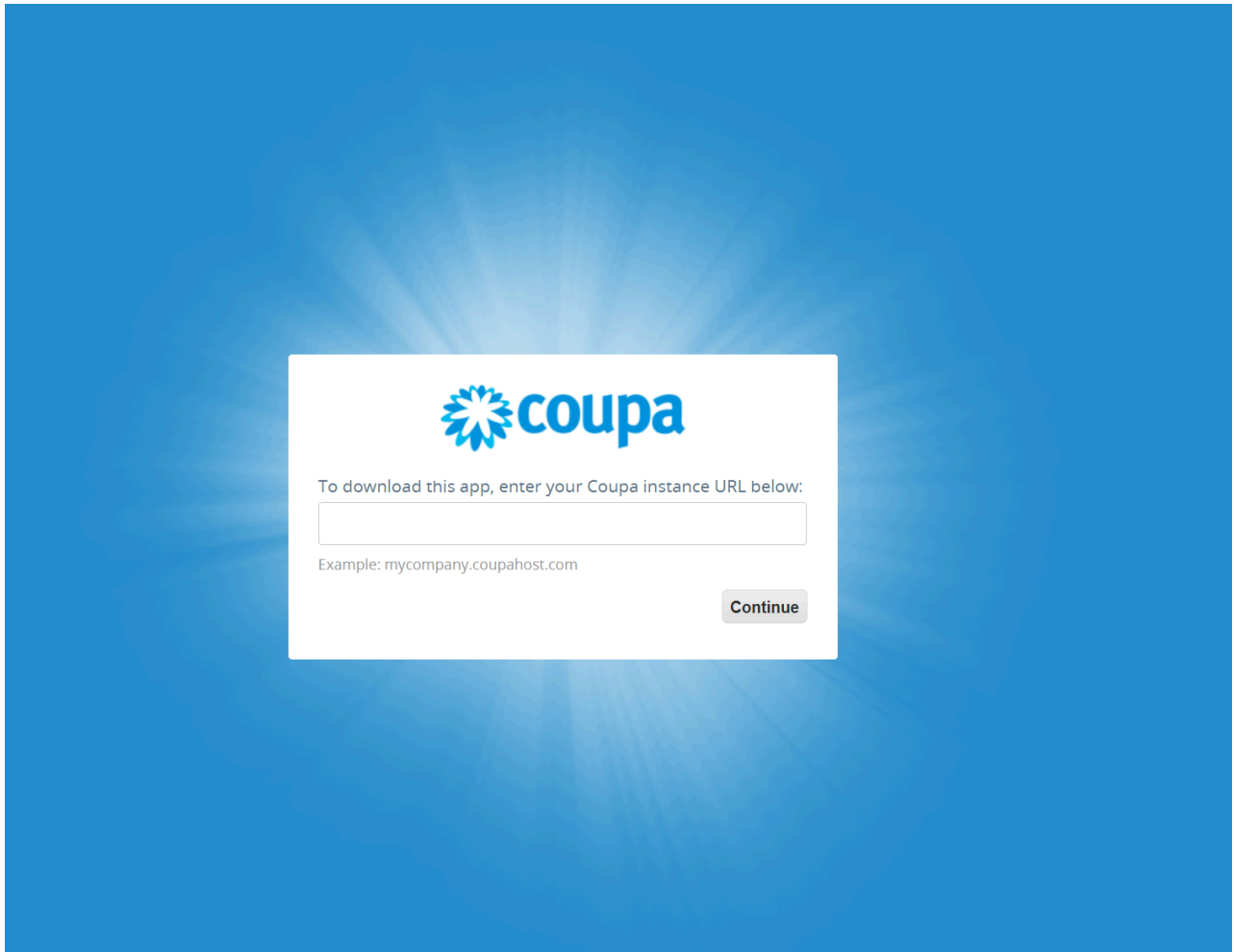

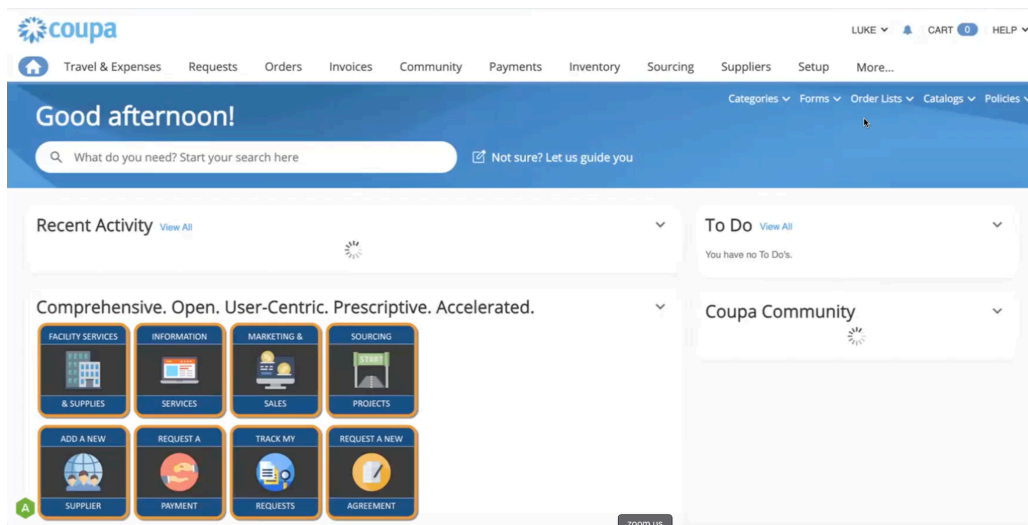
## Step 2 - CREATE an OAuth2/OpenID Connect Client in Coupa by following the steps outlined below

1. From the Coupa Admin Home page, click Setup (Integrations) & select Oauth/OpenID Connect Clients.
2. Click **Create**.
3. In the Create Client window, use the following values:
  - a. **Grant type** = Client credentials
  - b. **Name** = SecurityScorecard
  - c. **JWKS URI** = blank
  - d. **Login** = SecurityScorecard

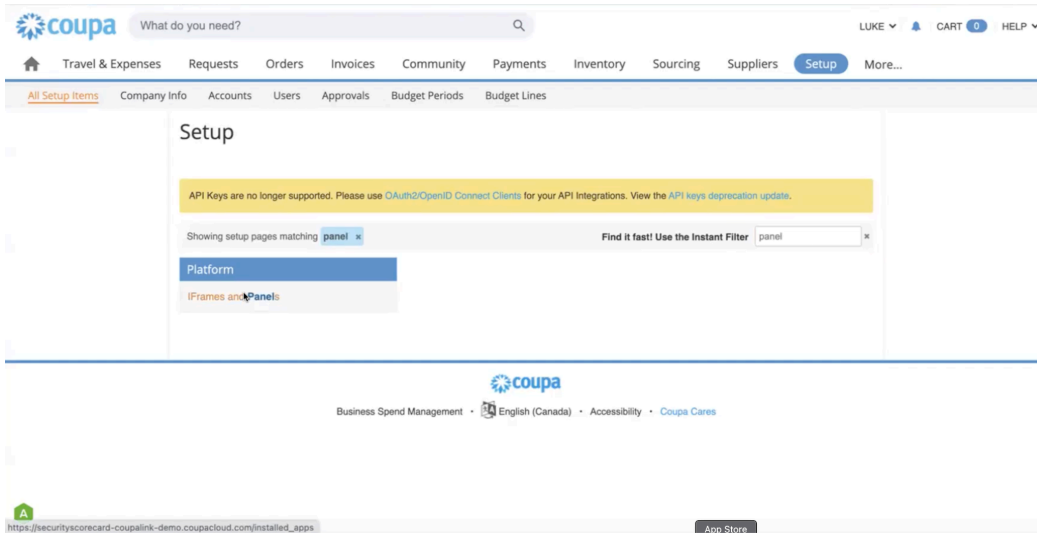
- e. **Contact First Name** = *your first name*
  - f. **Contact Last Name** = *your last name*
  - g. **Contact Email** = *your email address*
  - h. Select the following Scopes:
    - i. core.supplier.read
    - ii. core.supplier.risk\_aware.read
    - iii. core.supplier.risk\_aware.write
    - iv. core.supplier.write
4. After you click “Save” the **Identifier** and **Secret** will be displayed

### Step 3 - Configure the **SecurityScorecard Cybersecurity Risk Insights** App

1. From the home page of your Coupa dashboard, select **Setup** from the primary menu.




2. Search for **iFrames and Panels** under **Platform**.



3. Edit the **SecurityScorecard Cybersecurity Risk Insights App** to set the App Properties.

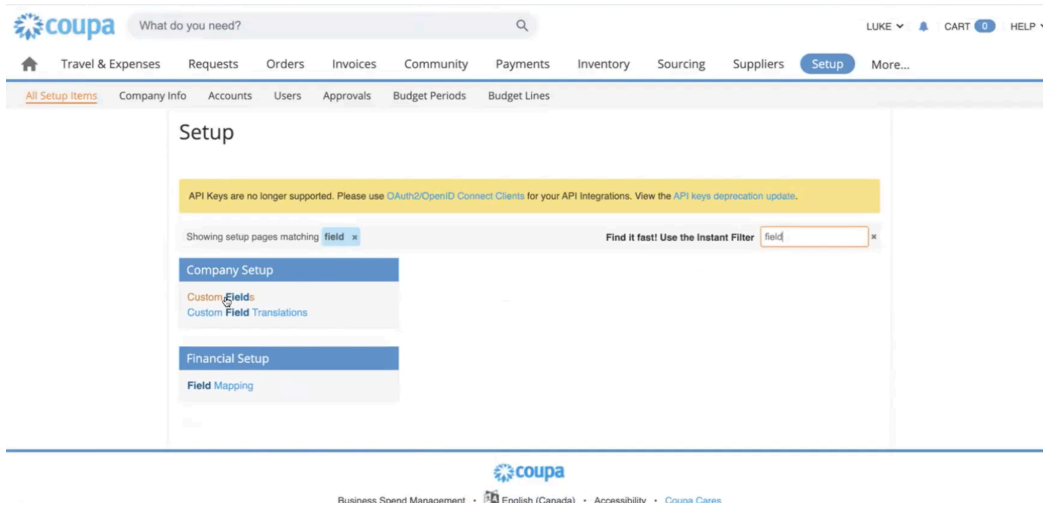

4. After entering the App Properties, check to make sure the app is enabled. In the Actions column for the app at Setup > IFrames and Panels, make sure the slider is set to the active position:



## Step 4 - Setup Custom Fields for SecurityScorecard

1. Return to the **Setup** page and search for **Custom Fields** under the Company Setup section.



2. At the top of the page under *Select an object to customize* use the dropdown menu to select **Suppliers**.

- b. **Field Name** = securityscorecard\_domain

- f. **Required** = No; leave unchecked
- g. Click **Done** when you are finished adding your information.

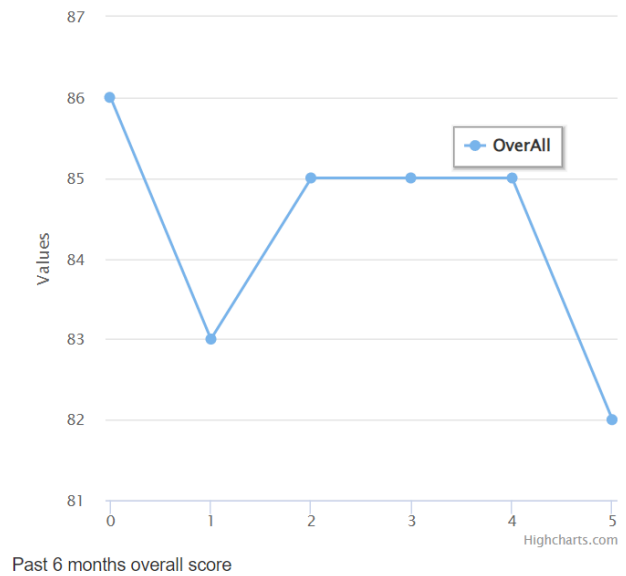

  - Active** = Yes; check the box



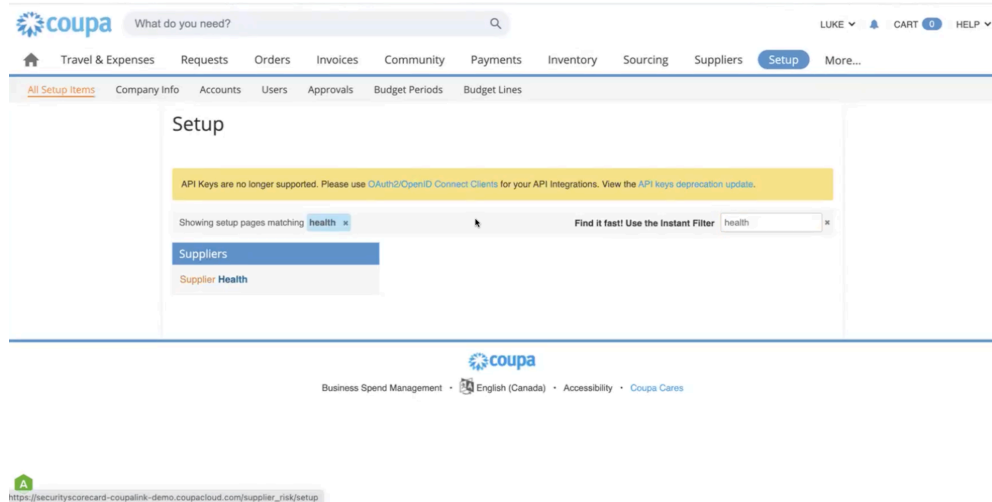

### Step 7 - Setup Supplier Health Module

1. Return to the **Setup** page and search for **Supplier Health** under the Suppliers section.



2. In the **Calibrate Risks** section (Setup > Suppliers > Supplier Health), you can assign weights to the risk criteria to create your own formula for evaluating supplier risk. If SecurityScorecard Ratings are your primary indicator of risk, SecurityScorecard recommends a high score (over 70%) to ensure the health score is a reflection of the SecurityScorecard Rating.

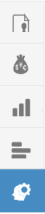
